NEWBUILDING/MAJOR REFURBISHMENT

Interlac 659 should always be applied over a recommended primer coating scheme. The primer surface should be dry and free from all contamination, and Interlac 659 must be applied within the overcoating intervals specified (consult the relevant product data sheet). Areas of breakdown, damage etc., should be prepared to the specified standard (e.g. Sa2½ (ISO 8501-1:2007) and primed prior to the application of Interlac 659
